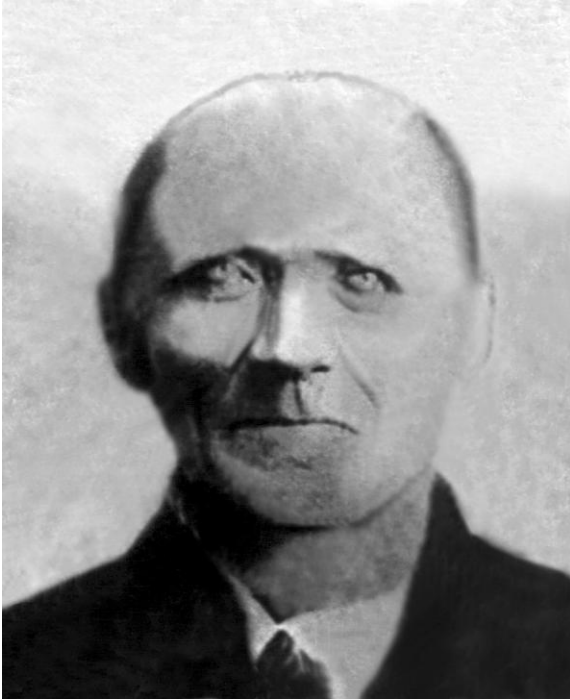


## ANDERS HANSEN



The family migrated to Manti in Sanpete county where Anders lived the remainder of his live.

Anders was a kind and temperate man and his sacrifices were many. He stayed true to the Church of Jesus Christ.

He died in Ephraim at the age of 83.

Anders Hansen was born June 29, 1802 in Barrit, Vejle, Denmark to Hans Hansen and Anne Andersen. Married Aballona Knudsen July 25, 1840. They had six children: two sons and four daughters. Died June 1, 1884 in Ephraim, Sanpete, Utah.

Anders and his wife lost an infant son and an infant daughter before leaving Denmark to come to Utah. They had three children that left Denmark with them: Maria, 16; Jorgen, 11 and Anne, 4. While crossing the ocean Jorgen died and was buried at sea.

The family arrive in New York in February of 1856 and continued their journey to St. Louis. While in St. Louis their youngest daughter became sick and died and a new baby girl was born.

They sailed up the Missouri River to Nebraska. They were then assigned to the Knute Petersen handcart company, crossed the plains and arrived in the Salt Lake Valley September 20, 1856.
